HNC Childhood Practice	BA (Hons) Child and Youth Studies, year 2 BA (Hons) Childhood Practice, year 2	<ul> <li>For BA (Hons) Childhood Practice:</li> <li>have at least two years' work experience in an appropriate setting PLUS</li> <li>A recognised SSSC practitioner qualification such as HNC Childhood Practice OR A relevant SCQF level 7 qualification, for example: Social Services: Children and Young People; Children's Care Learning and Development/Playwork; or equivalent. For applicants without sufficient credits, modules are available to help you reach the required level</li> <li>You must be employed within a relevant workplace environment</li> </ul>
HNC Civil Engineering	BEng (Hons) Civil Engineering (Graduate Apprenticeship), year 2.	B or above in graded unit 1. You must be in full time employment as a trainee Civil Engineer or Civil Engineer Technician and have the approval of your employer prior to application.
HNC Cyber Security	BSc (Hons) Computing, year 2	Candidates must have completed the following, or the equivalent of, Higher National units: Relational Database Systems and Publishing on the Internet or E-Commerce: Publishing websites.
HNC Fitness, Health and Exercise	BSc (Hons) Sport and Fitness, year 2	Successful applicants will be required to complete a PVG Disclosure Check and become PVG Scheme Members in order to undertake this course.

HNC Social Services	BA (Hons) Health and Social Studies, year 2	12 SCQF credits with 3 additional SCQF credits at level 7 which is equivalent to 120 degree credit points, and at least grade C in the Graded Unit will be considered for direct entry to year two.
HNC Sports Coaching and Development	BA (Hons) Adventure Tourism Management, year 2 BA (Hons) Adventure Education, year 2 BSc (Hons) Adventure Performance and Coaching, year 2	Successful completion of 120 credits at SCQF level 7 and C in graded unit. All students are interviewed as to their suitability and should be able to demonstrate a clear practical commitment, and provide a log of practical to adventure-based activities
HND Accounting	BA (Hons) Accounting and Finance, year 3	Income tax module, if available.
HND Beauty Therapy	BSc (Hons) Integrative Healthcare, year 3.	May require interview. Successful applicants will be required to complete a PVG Disclosure
HND Business	BA (Hons) Business and Management, year 3	C or above in graded unit.
HND Business with Information Technology	BA (Hons) Business and Management, year 3	C or above in graded unit.
HND Creative Arts	BA (Hons) Art and Contemporary Practices, year 3 BA (Hons) Fine Art, year 3	B or above in the Graded Unit. This is a Category 2 PVG course: PVG Scheme membership is required for specific optional modules/unit(s), where there is guaranteed contact with vulnerable groups in optional module/unit(s), but an alternative pathway exists to achieve target qualification.
